

## **Bilateral program funded from Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark (MFA) provides grants for development research activities as part of Denmark's international development cooperation. The objective of the Danish support to development research is to generate new knowledge capable of alleviating development problems and strengthening research capacity in the Danida priority countries which are (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Bolivia, Burkina Faso, Burma, Ethiopia, Ghana, Indonesia, Kenya, Mali, Mozambique, Nepal, Niger, Pakistan, **Palestine Territories**, Sudan, Somalia, Tanzania, Uganda, Vietnam, and Zimbabwe).

### Themes

Theme 1: Governance in fragile and unstable environments

Theme 2: Green economy, inclusive growth and employment

Theme 3: Rights to natural resources

Duration of the grants is up to 5 years, and the grant amount is up to USD 800000 to USD 1600000.
